The US solar industry lost 3.8 percent of its jobs, about 9,800 workers, in 2017.

While the industry saw record-setting growth in 2016, activity slowed because of policy challenges in some states and uncertainty over Trump's tariffs on imported solar panels.

But the long-term job trajectory is still very positive. The domestic industry had a total of 250,271 employees last year, a 168-percent increase from 2010.
