Registration by Mail and Online Registration ends October 17, 2018!

Deadline to request an Absentee Ballot is November 1, 2018!

In person absentee voting for most municipalities in Chippewa County begins October 22nd. Some have already begun. Check with your own municipality for your starting date. Then VOTE!

Go to <https://myvote.wi.gov/en-us/> to check to see if you are registered to votes, to find your voting information, to find your polling place, to find out what's on your ballot, to update your name or address, to find out how to register to vote, and how to vote absentee.
